
Air Quality future plans for London



Air Quality in London

- Air pollution in London has caused the UK to breach European health based standards.
- 1,000 premature deaths were predicted to occur in 2005 in London from particulate (PM₁₀) pollution.
- Poor air quality reduces our life-expectancy by 8 months (European average).
- Air pollution worsens respiratory and cardiovascular conditions, including asthma.
- Air pollution contributes to and is affected by climate change.



Mayor's Air Quality Strategy Low Emission Zone

- Scheme order currently out for consultation
- HGVs, buses and coaches Euro III for PM from 2008 & Euro IV from 2012
- Heavy vans and minibuses Euro III for PM from 2010

Emission Influenced Congestion Charging

- Proposals are under development, aimed at encouraging lower emission cars
- Incentives for lower emission cars could be introduced from 2008
- Higher charges for high polluters could be introduced from 2008/9.
- This initiative will require full public and stakeholder consultation during 2007.

- London Bus Improvement Programme
- Hydrogen Programme
- Other GLA Group vehicles
- Mayor's Taxi Emission Strategy
 - All London taxis to meet Euro III for NOx and PM by mid- 2008
